The Curriculum
 Some of you might be aware that the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) framework was updated in September 2021 along with the development matters. This is the government's non-statutory curriculum guidance which we choose to follow within our setting.
At Nunney Pre-School we have been working hard to deliver a curriculum for all children during their time with us. We have created many programs which our team has been implementing since the term started.
The team have worked hard on creating fun and exciting activities to sit within the programs. One of our favourite programs is called YAMYAM; it stands for Yoga and Mindfulness, Young Active Minds. This program branches out into several developmental areas – Personal, Social and Emotional Development, Physical Development and Expressive Art and Design.

This Term

First term back and we have been super busy; and already had lots of fun!
From learning all about themselves, friends and adults here to sharing our summer fun with everyone.

With the topic all about me – we drew pictures, measured ourselves, used playdough to make faces and talk to one another about the differences and similarities we have.

Over the next few weeks, we will be exploring harvest, space and getting prepared for Halloween.

Harvest

This year for Harvest the children will be making their own display out the front of the building for you to all see.

We will be learning facts about harvest, and autumn. Looking into the season more about the changes we notice around us to the drop in temperature and what clothes we should wear in the colder weather.

WHAT TO BRING?

Please make sure that all clothing items are named. It is difficult to locate these without names in.

All children will need a nursery bag with wellies, a spare change of clothes, underwear and shoes (if toilet training).

- We ask that children do not bring personal items or toys to nursery, we cannot be responsible for these if they get lost.

Drop off and Collection

We have been in discussion with the school regarding the new entrance we are using.

It is working well; however please can I ask that after entering and leaving the grounds please ensure you pull the bolts and latches across to ensure we keep all the children and families safe.

The gate will be open from 8.30am - 9am and a member of staff will go down to lock them with a padlock.

And again, it will be open from 2.30pm - 3.30pm and staff will be closing it again.

Please can we ask that you are punctional at collection time. Staff do finish work at 3.30pm.

For any reason including afternoon drop off or pick up we will need to use school's main gate where the buzzer system is.

We have a risk assessment in place with the school and need parents and families to support us with managing the gates as safely as possible for all.

From using this gate, we are reducing any roadside incidents happening where parents gather during these busy periods. We are hoping to get a buzzer system on this gate as soon as we can, but it all takes time.

Home Learning

As some of you are aware already, we have Eddie teddy, who likes to come home with a child for a weekend to spend time with them and then when he comes back the children can share their adventure together to all of their friends.
